### A STOWABLE MULTI-ACCESS PLANE THAT LETS YACHT OWNERS GO FURTHER FOR FUN

**Yacht owners can** extend the reaches of their playground with the 'multi-access' two-seater Akoya by Lisa (Light Innovative Sport Aircraft) Airplanes. Built to touch down on land, sea or snow, the Akoya's swivelling wings allow it to be stored on a yacht. V-shaped hydrofoils make for comfortable take-off and landing alongside an owner's yacht, while only 100m (330ft) is needed for Akoya's arrival and departure.

Retractable skis that lock into place under Akoya's wheels mean that cruising can be

combined with a visit to the mountains. And there's no need to worry if you haven't got a pilot's licence.

For €300,000 Lisa offers a fully equipped Akoya, an ultralight pilot licence, and training on water and snow from Lisa's own instructors, an added safety measure given the specific nature of the multi-access technology. Made entirely of composites, Akoya adheres to microlight aircraft rules. Work on a second model has already begun — Hy-Bird will be an electric plane powered by solar energy and hydrogen.
